## Creating a Photo Cover

Use our pre-made PSD Photo Cover Templates on the CD provided.

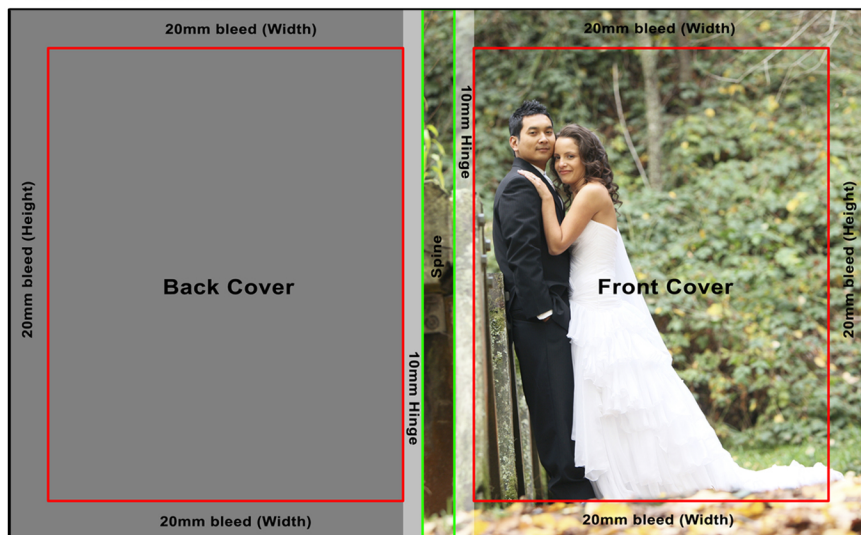
*\* Please note each type of book has different bleed, spine and hinge specification.*

- File needs to be 200DPI
- Do not put any important image or text in the hinge - 10mm either side of the spine.
- \* See images below
- Embedded profile is sRGB
- Save file as a PDF

### Photo Hard Cover and Dust Jacket Spine Widths

20 Pages	= +7mm
30 Pages	= +9mm
40 Pages	= +11mm
50 Pages	= +12mm
60 Pages	= +14mm
70 Pages	= +16mm

### Soft Cover Spine Widths

20 Pages	= +3mm
30 Pages	= +5mm
40 Pages	= +7mm
50 Pages	= +8mm
60 Pages	= +10mm
70 Pages	= +12mm

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## Creating a Page Layout

All pages are to have a 2.5mm bleed all around.  
e.g. a 255mm x 360mm page will be 260mm x 365mm with bleed.

Its advisable to keep any text or important image detail at least 10mm from the outer edge of each page. Additionally, allow an extra 5mm on the inner edge, (spine). Please see image below.



- Files need to be 200DPI
- Embedded profile is sRGB
- Files to be saved as JPEG
- Save pages in numerical order
- If image is a double page spread, save as two individual pages
- Each file name MUST have 3 digits commencing with "00".  
e.g. 001, 002, 003, etc.

## Saving as a Multi Page PDF

All completed pages are to be saved as a single Multi Page Document PDF from the created JPEG files.

- File > Automate > PDF Presentation
- Browse > Add Files
- Save (to specified folder)

PDF Options Window will follow

- Select JPEG
- Set Quality to 12
- Click OK
